Vendor Opportunities with US Wind

US Wind, Maryland's leader in offshore wind development, has contracts to develop two offshore wind energy projects that will generate enough clean, renewable energy to power 350,000 homes. US Wind is committed to achieving substantial involvement from Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs) and other local content businesses in all phases of our projects. The two projects now underway, MarWin and Momentum Wind, have subcontracting opportunities for a wide range of vendors needed to fill more than 4,500 jobs during construction. After construction, hundreds more will be needed for operations and maintenance, and for the Sparrows Point Steel manufacturing facility that will serve the entire U.S. offshore wind market.

What Types of Businesses Should Register?

Wind energy projects typically require hundreds of different products and components. Skilled labor is required to manufacture parts and build, assemble and maintain wind turbines and the infrastructure that supports them. Our early work will be focused on the Sparrows Point Steel manufacturing facility, which will include, but is not limited to:

- · Construction and Demolition
- Environmental and Mitigation Services
- Electrical and Utility Services
- Marine/Maritime Services
- · Manufacturing and Production
- Professional and Support Services

US Wind has agreements in place with United Steelworkers, the Baltimore-DC Building and Construction Trades, and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW).
