## Geotechnical Survey—Indian River Bay, Delaware <u>complete</u>!

US Wind has completed its 2023 campaign to conduct geotechnical surveys within Indian River Bay and Indian River, Delaware. The surveys were safely and successfully completed to better understand the Bay and River bottom profiles for the potential export cable route for the delivery of clean renewable energy from US Wind's offshore wind project.

In 2014, US Wind acquired a federal lease area off the coast of Maryland, which has the potential to generate approximately 2,000 MW in offshore wind power. In 2017, Maryland approved the company's ~300 MW **MarWin** project, and in December 2021, the state approved the 808 MW **Momentum Wind** project.
